As part of our Recruitment Programme we are looking to bowl over a new audience for the sport of bowls, with the introduction of a Bowls Australia-

backed Jack Attack initiative. Jack Attack is designed to increase social participation in the




sport of bowls, by filling the current gap in the market between competitive pennant play and social/barefoot/corporate bowls. The game's social, fast-paced format helps boost participation numbers, by appealing to people opposed to playing in longer traditional formats and by providing a more structured competition than barefoot bowls. Jack Attack capitalises on the success of the televised Bowls Premier League competition; closely replicating the style of play through its format and time-limits. Competition involves teams of three, with more players able to be registered to accommodate for busy lifestyles, and substitutions permitted in each game, with each match lasting little more than 60 minutes. We hope Jack Attack will be the catalyst for further participants trying their hand at the sport and rolling them

down more often. Jack Attack will be played regularly, over 6 weeks commencing Wednesday November 9th. Jack Attack entry forms are available at the Club so please sign up your friends and neighbours. Cost is just \$30 per week per team, irrespective of the number of players.

Tickets are just \$10 so look for the list in the foyer to signup.



The bar and BBQ will be there to quench players thirsts and fill the hunger pangs.








#### **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- Open Handicap Singles Sunday 29 January 2023 at 5.00pm
- Mixed Pairs Wednesday 15 February 2023 at 5.00pm
- Men's & Ladies' Minor Singles Sunday 19 February 2023 at 5.00pm

#### Time For Change

One topic that was raised at the Time For Change Sessions was the need to improve the ambience in the clubhouse. A number of suggestions were put forward.



Headed up by John Renowden we have presented our initial thoughts to the Shire about extending the size of the clubhouse. A set of more detailed plans have been drawn up and we are now awaiting an indicative quote to add nine metres onto the west end of the clubhouse.

In addition we have been invited by the Bendigo Community Bank to submit an application to their Community Grants Program. They are making available \$200,000 to be split between 20 community groups.

Our thoughts are to request funds to help us to replace the tables and chairs plus incorporate partitions to break up the area depending on the number of people attending an event. We have received some suggestions from one organisation and will be briefing one of our new Petanque members Gilles Bachet, who has considerable experience in this field, to propose an alternative solution.

Consideration is also being given to improving the appearance of the terrace outside the front

A feature of this Medley is that members have the opportunity to play in a range of game formats and team positions.


We have Ladies and Men's Singles, Ladies and Men's Pairs, Mixed Triples and Mixed 4s.
